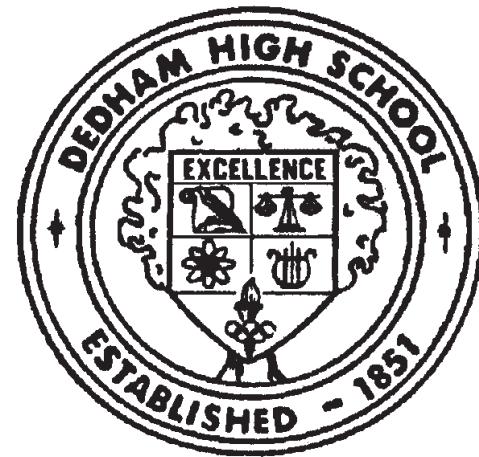

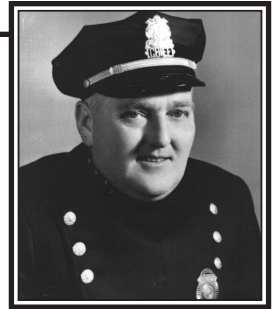

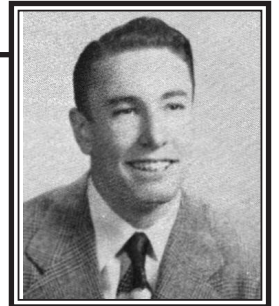
**Walter Carroll 1927**

3 sport athlete at Dedham High School...three years of football, three years of basketball, and four years of baseball... In the Dedham Transcript on April 1, 1927 an unnamed correspondent wrote that "Dedham has a most promising athlete in young Walter Carroll, one who is destined to make his mark in college athletics"... For the football team his leg pinned many teams deep in their own territory while at fullback he was one of the top offensive performers punishing defenses and often exploiting his pitching arm by tossing forward passes confusing opponents... On the basketball team recognition as top scorer or rebound leader was not uncommon, especially in his senior year as Captain where they made it to the final 8 in the M.I.T Tournament... Baseball was another success story... A solid power pitcher with consistent accuracy earned him much respect in front of the plate while his bat spoke for him at the plate...Walter was one of the outstanding members of the Dedham High School baseball team leading in both fielding and hitting... Walter Carroll's achievements made it easy to identify him as a promising athlete well in control of his own destiny.



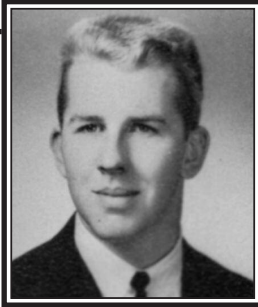
**Tom York 1949**

3 sport athlete...Earned 11 varsity letters...four in football, four in track, and three in baseball ...Captain of the 1948 football team...Co-Captain of the track team his senior year...Competed in the 200, 440, 300, and 50 yard dash as well as the javelin and shot put...a record setting time in the 50 yard dash at 5.8 seconds...setting a record which stood over 20 years in the 300 yard dash with a time of 32.9 seconds...Selected to represent Dedham at Massachusetts Boy's State and being chosen to be a representative in Washington at Boy's Nation...Continued to participate in running events post high school while attending Yale until an injury forced him to abandon his plans to train and compete in the upcoming Olympics.



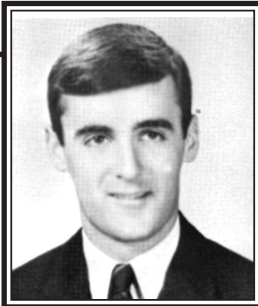
## ***Paul Cady Sr. 1965***

4 sport athlete...Football, indoor track, basketball, and outdoor track... Earning 9 varsity letters...three in football, one in indoor track, two in basketball, and three in outdoor track ... Named to All Scholastics football team...Captained the basketball team his senior year and selected as a league All Star ...Setting both a school scoring and rebound records as a senior...Track accomplishments include a school shot-put record...Many memorable moments on and off the athletic field where he took what he learned when joining the Navy in 1966 only to return to Dedham in 1972 joining the Police Department.



## ***Bob Crisp 1968***

2 sport athlete...6 varsity letters...Three in football, and three in hockey ... Played on the Bay State Conference Co-Championship football team in 1967 and the 1966 state semi-finalist hockey team... Returned as a Coach for both Football and Hockey and was Awarded Assistant Coach of the Year by the Massachusetts Hockey Coaches Association in 2002...Member of the Dedham High Boosters Club Board of Directors ... Personally involved with the Boosters Decal Drive and School Pride Day at the High School since its inception... Dedham High Alumni Association Fundraising Committee Board Member and event volunteer... Instrumental in the establishment and upkeep of the Dedham High School Weight Room... Dedham Education Association Volunteer of the Year award 2002...2004 Dedham High School Athletic Hall of Fame Inductee.

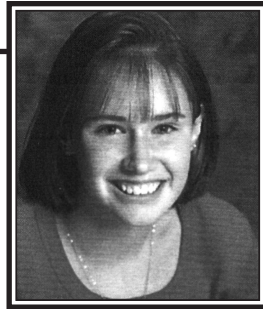

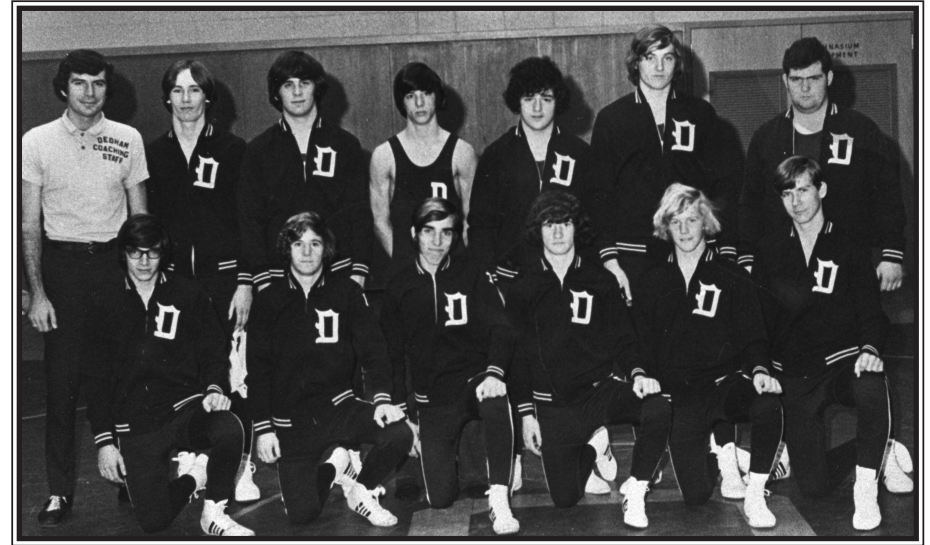
## ***Jackie Burbank 2000***



3 sport athlete...Earning 10 letters...two in soccer, four in winter track, and four with spring track... Captain of the winter and spring track and field teams as a senior... Member of two Herget Division Championship track teams and the 1999 Herget Division Championship soccer team... School individual records include 300m, 400m, and the 600m... Records also include part of the 4 X 400m relay in 1997 and the State high jump relay team in 1999... Went from winning recognition for the Most Improved for indoor track as a sophomore to being named the team MVP the following two years... won MVP as a junior for spring track, the Double "E" Award, Outstanding female track athlete award, and the sportsmanship award in soccer as a senior... Awards and honors did not stop upon graduation... At Stonehill College and 4 years of track Jackie set 8 school records and numerous NE-10 Conference Championships.

## ***1972-73 to 1975-76 Wrestling Teams***

1972-73 team had a record of 15-0 winning both the Bay State League and the Division I South sectionals...1973-74 team had a record of 13-0 winning the Bay State League and placing 3rd overall in the Division I South with three individuals named sectional champions ...1974-75 team had a 16-0 record winning the Bay State League and the Division I South sectionals with three individuals named sectional champions ...1975-76 team won the Division I South sectionals and had three individuals as sectional champions and one ranked 4th in the state... The four years of success was accomplished under Coach Jim Police and included setting a state record with 52 consecutive dual meet victories...The following athletes were involved with the Wrestling Teams four year success story: Brian Arrone, Rick Belanger, Mike Belanger – Capt. 1974-75, Dave Berry, Dave Boisvert, Dame Canham – Capt. 1975-76, Steve Chanty, John Ceglarski, Dan Coffey – Capt. 1972-73, Mike Coffey – Capt. 1973-74, Glen Farrell, Dave Freitas – Capt. 1972-73, Jim Griffiths, John Griffiths – Capt. 1975-76, Mike Healey, Walter Healey, Bill Hoefer, Fran Kent, John Krone, Tom Levesque, Steve Maher, Bill Morrissey – Capt. 1974-75, Joe Musto, Dick Nighelli – Capt. 1973-74, Bob Primeau, Sal Spada, Bill Tascoyenes, Matt Thomas – Capt. 1972-73, Chris Tighe, Mike Ward, and Bill Wood.

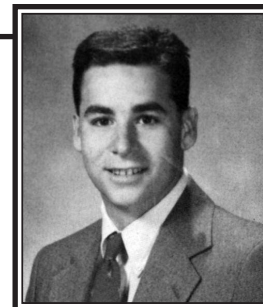
## ***Marion Kelly 1977***

3 sport athlete...7 varsity letters...Three in field hockey, one in basketball, and three in softball...Captain of the field hockey team as a senior ...Playing one of the most demanding roles as goal keeper... Included in her many great accomplishments on the field was shutting down one of the first male field hockey players on a breakaway... Play of this caliber helped her get singled out as an All Star... Captain of the softball team as a senior... Recognized as an All Star on the softball field... Her abilities allowed her to continue playing softball in college.



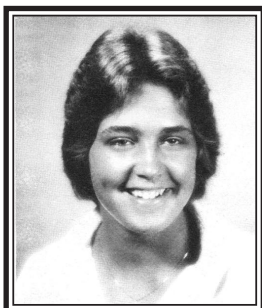
## ***Thomas McLeish 1988***

3 sport athlete...Earning 7 letters...Three in football, two in indoor track, and two with spring track... Recognitions in football include being named All-Conference, All-State, Transcript All-Star, and Patriot Ledger All-Scholastic... As a senior was elected as captain and won the Heaphy Award... Member of the Bay State Conference Championship team... Captain of both winter and spring track teams... Conference All-Star and Transcript All-Star both winter and spring track teams as a senior... Won the outstanding track athlete award in both the winter and spring seasons as a senior... Awarded the Double "E" Award Winner in 1988... Continued his athletic success at Old Miss and in the Arena Football League before returning to Dedham as a Teacher and Coach.



## ***Elizabeth Patterson – Lowrie 1982***

Earned 7 letters playing 3 sports...Three letters for basketball and four letters in track and field... Captained both the basketball and track teams as a senior... Patriot Ledger All-Scholastic, Three time Daily Transcript All-Star, Daily Transcript girls All-Star Outstanding Performer... Consecutive years as Bay State League Outstanding Field events performer... Bay State Conference Meet Champion – Discus 1982, Bay State Conference Meet shot put 1st place in 1981, Bay State Conference Meet shot put 2nd place 1980, Bay State Conference Meet javelin 3rd place 1979... Eastern Mass Class B Champion in shot put... League and school record holder in the shot and discus... Dedham High School Track and Field MVP in 1982.



## ***Paul Cady Jr. 1993***

4 sport athlete... Earning 10 letters... One letter in cross country, two in soccer, three in basketball, and 4 in track and field... Soccer accomplishments include winning the Unsung Hero Award and being named a Daily Transcript All-Star... Bay State Conference All-Star and Patriot Ledger All-Scholastic as a senior... two-time Daily Transcript All-Star... Three consecutive years as track and field team MVP... Bay State Conference All-Star recognition in the triple jump three years running, and in the high hurdles back to back seasons... Held school records in the triple jump at 45'5" and the high hurdles with a time of 14.4 seconds...three time Daily Transcript All-Star, two time Patriot Ledger All-Scholastic... Edward T Peterson Memorial award Outstanding DHS track Performer... Continued running at the University of Massachusetts at Dartmouth.
